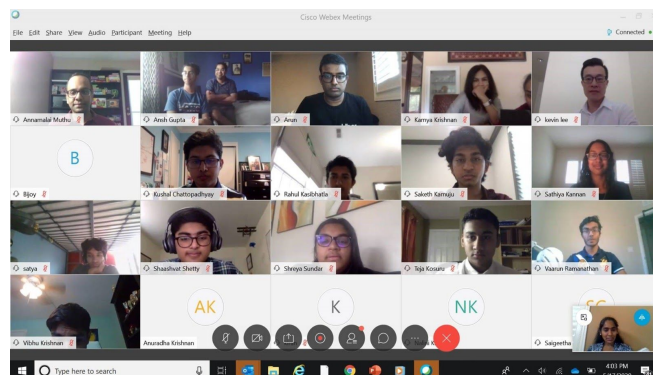
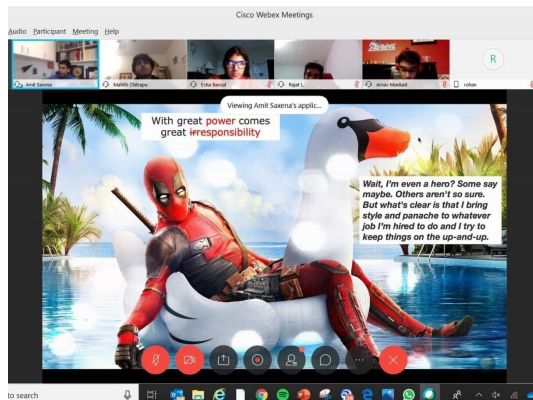
NEBULA Youth Camp - Spring 2020

The first set of April Cohort Online Incubator graduated on Sunday, May 17, 2020, with an amazing pitch and demo presentation. The 2 teams spent 4 weeks in online classes with professional mentors and our own peer mentors – Vaarun and Ansh.

In such a short period of time, the teams learned to develop mobile applications, created an entire working prototype of their products, and delivered a pitch on their companies to the 2 professional judges – an Operations Manager at Uber, and a former Data Scientist and now professor at UC Berkeley. One team created a product aiming to upgrade the gadgets in our home, and the other proposed a Book Rental App.

The proceeds from this camp will fund the college education of 3 students !

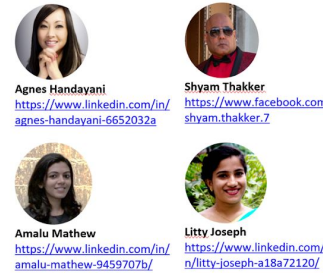

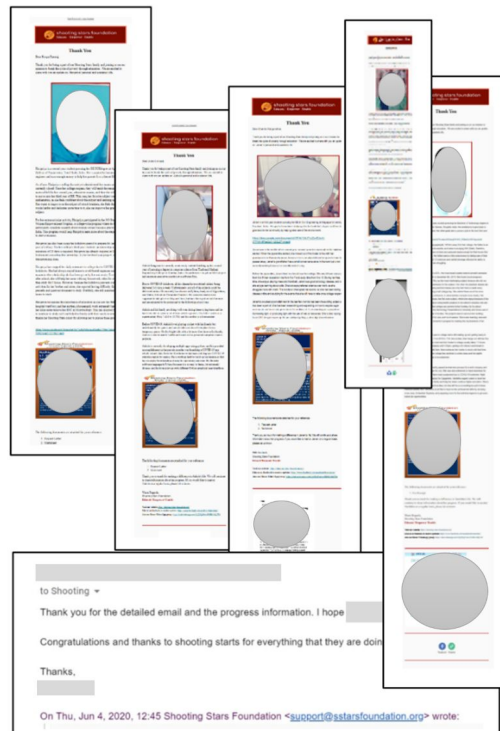
